## Recordings

## Miller's Cave (Single, 2019, Match-up Zone Music)

On September 4, 2019, The Miners released their cover of Cowboy Jack Clement's, *Miller's Cave*, as a digital only single. The single was recorded and mixed entirely at Keith Marlowe's Match-up Zone Studio, mastered by Joe Lambert of Joe Lambert Mastering and self-released through Marlowe's own Match-up Zone Music. *Miller's Cave* has previously been recorded by Gram Parsons, Charlie Pride, Doug Sahm, Bobby Bare, Hank Snow and others. The Miners version is different than any other version recorded with a more straight ahead country feel highlighted by a pedal steel and electric guitar solo. *Miller's Cave* is already receiving airplay on Radio Free Americana (Internet; Verona, VA) and ALL FM 96.9 (Manchester, UK) and has been written up in the blog Adobe and Teardrops.

#### Miners' Rebellion (EP, 2012, Match-up Zone Music)

**The Miners** debut release, *Miner's Rebellion*, is a six-song EP recorded at Keith Marlowe's Match-up Zone Studio and released November 5, 2012 digitally and on CD. The EP's 6 tracks are all original songs penned by Marlowe and was recorded entirely on 8-track ½" reel-to-reel tape and mixed and mastered at Philly's MilkBoy The Studio. Marlowe produced and engineered all of the 8-track sessions while Marlowe and MilkBoy's Joel Metzler, mixed the EP. *Miners' Rebellion* is self-released through Marlowe's own Match-up Zone Music.

*Miners' Rebellion* received much critical acclaim including being chosen as  $\frac{#1 \text{ debut release of } 2013}{\text{Tunes}}$  blog, being chosen as one of the <u>Top 10 of 2013</u> by **Adobe and Teardrops** blog and being chosen as a <u>Best of 2013</u> by UK radio show **Standing in the Shadows of Lev**. It received two write ups on **No Depression** as well as several other notable music blogs in the U.S. and UK.

*Miners' Rebellion* also received notable airplay on terrestrial and interest radio in the U.S. and Europe including **WXPN** (Philadelphia, PA), **Radio Free Americana** (Internet; Verona, VA) and **ALL FM 96.9** (Manchester, UK). It was also featured on several notable Americana focused podcasts such as **Freight Train Boogie** (#194 and #219), **The Miller Tells Her Tale** (Podcast #451), and **Americana Rock Mix** (Podcast #166).

# Live

The Miners focus their live shows primarily at the Philly area's top venues such as **World Café Live** (downstairs and upstairs), **MilkBoy Philly** and **118 North**. The Miners have opened for national touring acts including **John Wesley Harding** (Wesley Stace); **Roger Clyne and the Peacemakers**, and **Don Dixon**. For five years, The Miners have hosted a sold-out benefit at World Café Live (upstairs) for Breast Cancer charities such as Living Beyond Breast Cancer.
